

**The Security Printing Corporation (Bangladesh) Ltd (SPCBL),  
Gazipur.**

**Minutes of Pre-bid meeting on e-tender no. 34/2016-17 for supply, installation, testing  
& commissioning of 01 (one) no. 04 (four) Color sheet fed wet offset printing machine.**

A pre-bid meeting regarding the captioned tender was held on the 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 at the Board Room of the SPCBL. The Managing Director of the SPCBL presided over the meeting. The other representatives of the SPCBL who attended the meeting were as follows :

The President welcomed the above representatives of the intending tenderers and invited them to raise any issue they feel to be explicated on the technical specifications as well as terms and conditions set forth in the tender schedule. The representative of M/s Graphic Solution Ltd., Dhaka drew attention of the president regarding point D.A 3, 7, 11 a, 12 c, 13 b, c, 14 c, d and B7 of the tender schedule. The said points were discussed openly and elaborately in the meeting and some amendments were made unanimously against some points. The representative of M/s Reliance International, Dhaka proposed to decrease the range of Gripper Margin from (8 to 12) mm to (9 to 11) mm which was accepted by SPCBL side. After a long and cordial discussion, the following decisions were taken :

Besides the letter of 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2017 sent by M/s Komori Corporation, Japan on certain queries was placed and discussed in the meeting. Against point no. 1 of the said letter the SPCBL side informed that final printed products with the machine in question will be all security documents other than Bank notes/currency notes. SPCBL side also informed that Targeted "Base Substrate (s)" will be Wood Pulp/Chemical Wood Pulp/Wood-Cotton mixed paper/CBS-1/Carbonless Paper/Manifold Paper/Coated Paper/Coated Board/Non-coated Board/Gummed Paper etc. against the query under point no. 2 of the said letter. Regarding requirement of specification of "Rainbow Printing" as asked in the point no. 3 of the above letter, the SPCBL side replied that specification of "Rainbow Printing" will not be required. But it will be no problem if this is an inherent/standard facility of the machine.

Having no other issues for discussion, the chair concluded the meeting with thanks to all. This minutes will be treated as an integral part of the tender schedule.
